iFAST Metro Race 2014 More than 600 people ran in the dark for charity

12 November 2014, Hong Kong — iFAST Metro Race 2014 was held on 7 November with more than 600 participants running in the dark. All the proceeds raised were donated to Unleash Foundation in an effort to enhance the competitiveness and confidence of disabled youth by funding their education and training.

Titled sponsored by iFAST Financial (HK) Limited ("iFAST") and organised by Y2Y Orienteering Development and Training Centre, the race was in its second year. iFAST, putting words into action, joined and invited industry peers to participate in this event. Each team in the open category donated HKD300 while each team in the corporate category donated HKD4,000. The champion of the corporate category were Cheung Chi Ko Abdon, Tam Wing Chung and Man Chi Kin from iFAST, while the first- and second-runner ups were from iFAST and Sun International Financial Group respectively.

Similar to last year's race, some of the checkpoints featured special investment questions whereby bonus scores were awarded to participants with the right answers. Each race participant was given a booklet with articles related to mutual fund and bond investments, which could be referenced to score more points at various checkpoints throughout the race. Through this both physically and intellectually demanding event, iFAST hoped to promote a healthy lifestyle that emphasised on the importance of both physical and financial health, enhancing participants' financial knowledge and helping them apply such knowledge as a way to improve their lives.
